



Making a real difference to the day to day lives of people and families living with a disability.

Supported Living Services

A service supporting people with learning disabilities and complex needs to live in their own homes and communities across Lancashire.

Our Supported Living Service helps people with learning disabilities to live independently in their own home.

We believe that people with learning disabilities should have the choice of where they live and the opportunity to grow in confidence and learn the necessary skills to take control of their own lives.

We work to help this happen by:

Allowing people to grow in confidence and encouraging them to reach their potential

Empowering people to take control of their lives

Helping people to live independently and to make their own decisions

Developing people's skills and creating new opportunities

Promoting health and wellbeing

Supporting people to access facilities within the community

Support available from 1 hour to 24 hours a day

Making friends and trusting relationships brings a sense of community and contributes to the emotional wellbeing of everyone. Creating long lasting and happy memories to all who use our services is really important to us...above all we want to share smiles and laughter and know that we are making lives better for everyone we support.

Learning Disability Services

Vision in People (VIP)

A day service for people with learning disabilities in Lancashire.

Our VIP service is based in Preston and offers a wide range of fun, stimulating activities and learning opportunities to people with learning disabilities.

We believe that people with learning disabilities should be able to flourish, gain confidence, make friends and reach their potential.

Set in large and pleasant grounds, our service helps to make this happen by providing a fully accessible, safe and caring environment which:

Offers a varied range of learning, leisure and social activities

Provides a person centred, tailored approach

Develops independence skills and selfconfidence

Encourages self-expression, for example, through drama and dance

Provides a stimulating and friendly environment

Offers a range of workshops and educational activities

Gives support with personal relationships and friendships

Our VIPs take part in planned off-site visits to places of interest that expand their knowledge and skills, including volunteering and work experience opportunities. Importantly, having fun and enjoying each day is built in!

Learning Disability Services

The FX Service

A day service for people with profound and multiple learning disabilities in Lancashire

Our FX service, based in Preston, offers a wide range of fun, stimulating activities for people with profound learning disabilities.

We believe that people with profound and multiple disabilities should have opportunities to enjoy stimulating and fun activities, and that their health needs however complex, should not be a barrier to having new and exciting experiences.

Set in the heart of the city, our project helps to make this happen by providing a fully accessible, safe and caring environment which offers:

Medical support from a full time nurse

Creative ways to enhance communication

A personalised individual approach

Accessible mini buses for outings and day trips

Modern accessible equipment and facilities

A varied range of community, leisure and social activities

Dance, sensory drama, art and music to encourage self-expression

Working closely with service users and their families, social care and health professionals, we respond to the needs of every person who comes to us, whatever their disability. Importantly, having fun and enjoying each day is built in.

Plungington Community Centre


Providing a range of activities and entertainment for people of all ages.

Plungington Community Centre is set in the University Quarter of Preston just outside the city centre. The former school building is a central hub providing a range of activities and entertainment for people of all ages.

We believe that everyone in the community should have local access to affordable activities that improve health and wellbeing and reduce social isolation.

The centre has a large hall, including a stage, and a number of smaller rooms, all available for hire by community groups. Our community centre Café offers a warm space and friendly environment for people to meet and share a coffee and a snack. The café also provides volunteer opportunities for people wanting to learn new skills or give something back to the community. We are always looking for groups and individuals that can offer something new to the community or just need a space for an event or meeting!

Vincent House for the Homeless

Providing accommodation and support for the homeless in Blackpool.

Set in Blackpool, Vincent House provides accommodation and support to men and women who find themselves homeless.

We believe that everyone should have a home to call their own, and the chance to make a better life. We provide emergency and supported accommodation to give people the support they need to regain their independence and to take responsible steps towards integrating into the community.

Vincent House offers:

Supported accommodation for people aged 18-65

An emergency unit for people aged over 25

Assistance with money advice and benefits.

Resettlement and tenancy advice

Life-skills development and team work

Community engagement and volunteering

Employment pathways

Craft, sport and leisure activities

Everyone who comes to Vincent House is given the positive encouragement and personalised support they need to help them to make a better future and move on successfully into their own homes.
